

The Dalles Swim Team 2008 Behavior Agreement

The purpose of The Dalles Swim Team is to provide a positive swimming experience for all swimmers, regardless of age or ability. When members of the team are disruptive in their behavior, their actions interfere with the learning process of their teammates.

Team Coaches will use their own discretionary discipline such as laps, push-ups, etc. before entering into the formal discipline process.

When the above does not work, coaches or someone they designate will notify parents that their child needs to be picked up from the pool or swim meet.

Three steps will then result:

1. The swimmer will not be allowed to attend the next three practices
2. The swimmer must meet with parent(s), coach(s), and the Team Manager before being allowed back into practice
3. The parent or a parent appointed adult, will need to attend the next practice session with the swimmer

If a swimmer is removed from practice/meet three (3) times, they will be removed permanently from the team for the season with no reimbursement of funds.

Each swimmer must sign a "Discipline Agreement" at registration. The agreement must be renewed once a year and will be kept on file.

I agree to follow my coach's instruction and act responsibly.

I understand that if I do not act in a responsible manner, I will be asked to leave practice or the meet.

I may even be asked to quit the team.
