

# 2010 Summer Meet Information

**Summer Series** – 10 & Unders – Hood River, OR – 8-10 am Thursday mornings  
**June 17      July 8      August 5      \$5 each meet**

These meets are fun, practice meets designed for the younger or new swimmer who doesn't have much (or any) swim meet experience. The \$5 fee covers entry to the pool, and enough for certificates/ribbons.

**Goldendale** meet – This meet is hosted by our Goldendale swimmers, who train in Goldendale four days a week, and in The Dalles one day a week, and compete with us at meets. The pool is an outdoor, 25 yard, 6 lane pool, with a kiddie pool beside it. Warmups are 8:30 am. Lunch is served after the meet, \$2 per person, and the swimmers are welcome to stay and play at the pool.

**The Dalles** meet – This is our team meet, hosted completely by The Dalles swimmers and parents. This is a huge commitment of time and effort, and all of our team parents are needed, regardless of experience. The meet is Friday evening, and all day on Saturday and Sunday. Mornings are 12 & Under swimmers, and afternoons are 13 & Overs.

**Beaverton** meet – We have not attended this meet before, but it is at a very fast pool where the Tualatin Hills team practices. It is a 50 meter indoor pool. This is the same weekend as 10 & Under State Championships, so any kids qualified for State cannot swim at the Beaverton meet. It is a B/C meet for 10 & Under swimmers, and an open A/B/C meet for 11 & Overs.

**Redmond** meet – This meet is held at a 25 meter indoor pool in Redmond, about 2 and a half hours from The Dalles. It was a very fast meet for our swimmers last year, and very fun. Outside of the pool building, on the grass, you can camp overnight, and/or set up shade canopies. There is a very good speaker system, so that you know what is happening for events. A few miles north of Redmond is Lake Billy Chinook, with lots of waterskiing, houseboats, and a huge park/swim area. **John Day** meet – This meet is in John Day, located almost 4 hours drive from The Dalles. The drive is long, but the meet is worth it. If you ask any older swimmers, they have great memories of the fun they had at John Day. The pool is little and deep (not quite 25 yards), everyone camps at the park, they open the pool Saturday evening to families, and they do fun things like duckie races down the creek, parent relays, and watermelon relays for the kids after the meet on Sunday.
